There are 02 division in F.Y.B.A. [01 'A' Stream and 01 'B' Stream Division]

### **Principal / main Subjects :--**

Sanskrit, English, Gujarati, Hindi, History, Economics, Sociology.

### **Subsidiary Subjects :--**

Sanskrit, English, Gujarati, Hindi, Psychology, History, Economics, Sociology.

### **Important Conditions / criteria for Admission :--**

1. The candidate / student should have passed standard 12<sup>th</sup> [as per the pattern of 10+2], which should be recognized by the state Government / central Government /or other state Governments. The Admission is strictly on merit.
2. The Candidate who has passed std. 12<sup>th</sup> form central board or other state has board will have to obtain a provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC) otherwise he/she will not allowed admission provisional Eligibility Certificate in mandatory.
3. Having obtained admission in the College the Student is required to fill up the enrollment form of Gujarat University and pay the required fees. If the candidate fails to meet these requirements he/she will not be permitted to appear for the annual Examination and his/her admission will be considered cancelled

### **Important conditions after having obtained Admission:-**

1. It is compulsory for the student to take admission in N.C.C. or N.S.S. or sports.
2. It is mandatory for the student to fill the enrolment form of the University if this condition is not fulfilled the student will not be allowed to appear in the annual examination and his/her admission, will be considered as cancelled. While filling the enrolment form, one attested copy of standard XII<sup>th</sup> marksheet, two passport size photographs and Gujarat University Provisional eligibility certificate (PEC) (where ever applicable) should be attached.
3. The attendance is compulsory and is regularly taken in the collage. The student whose attendance falls short of the required number set by the University will not be allowed to appear in college as well as University examinations.
4. For all work pertaining to admission, examination as other work, the student should personally contact the office during office hours.
5. It is compulsory to appear in the first and second term exam of the college. Only under rare and unavoidable circumstances

which are beyond control, will the student be allowed to appear in the retest with pre-obtained permission of the Principal otherwise s/he will not be allowed to appear in Retest.

6. The fees of second term and University should be filled in the given time period / frame, else the admission will be cancelled.
7. The student is required to keep the college I-card with his/her person.

### **Examination :-**

1. It is compulsory to appear in the internal examination conducted by the college and the University Examination.
2. Structure of Marks & Calculation of % :-

3. Minimum required parsing Marks/ Percentage :-  
For compulsory English, compulsory sanskrit and second subsidiary :--  
Internal – 11/30  
University – 25/70  
The Marks for main paper 1 and main paper 2 are calculated together / jointly similarly the marks of First subsidiary paper 1 and paper 2 are calculated jointly, The marks required are as under  
Internal – 22/60  
University – 50/100  
If the student obtains less marks than the minimum required marks in main paper than she/he is required to appear in both

main paper1 and main paper 2 exams.

If the student obtains less than the required passing marks in First subsidiary than she/he is required to appear in both First subsidiary paper 1 and paper 2.

4. If the student obtains less than the required minimum marks in Internal examination conducted by the college than it is called Internal A.T.K.T.
5. If the Student obtains less than the required minimum marks in the University Examination the he gets External A.T.K.T.
6. The Students who obtains less marks than the minimum passing marks in 3 students gets an A.T.K.T. , but in allowed to take admission in second year but if the student gets less marks than the minimum required passing marks in more than 3 subjects she/he in considered as failed and in not allowed to take admission in second year.
7. If the Student has Internal A.T.K.T. then she/he is required to appear in the University exam of the subject two.
8. The Student who has an Internal A.T.K.T. is required to appear in the First and the Second Exam of the College.
9. Student who have External A.T.K.T. can appear in the Examination conducted by the University during the month of October November. The Forms for this examination are Provided by the University during end of September or the beginning of the month of October.
10. Those Student who are declared fail in the University Examination Conducted in the Month October – November. Such students can appear in the exams conducted by the University in the months of March – April the forms for this exam are available in the month of December.
