

ADMISSION IN S Y B COM IN ENGLISH MEDIUM

In the year 1997 the Commerce Stream was started in Gujarat Arts & Commerce College (Evening) Ahmedabad. S.Y.B.Com. classes started in the year 1998. The medium of instruction is Gujarati and English and Lectures are held in both the . There are two division in English medium and two division in Gujarati medium.

The Admission form of S.Y.B.Com. is available at the college office at the prescribed University fees.

Principal /Main Subjects : Advance Accountancy and Auditing.

Subsidiary Subjects : Advance Statistics.

Important Condition for Admission

1. The candidate should have passed F.Y.B.Com. Examination. Student who have a A.T.K.T. in F.Y.B.Com. are permitted to take admission in S.Y.B.Com.
2. If a Student belonging to a College affiliated to another University desire to take admission in the College. He/She will have to obtain a provisional Eligibility certificate (PEC) otherwise he/she will not be allow admission.
3. Student belonging to other College affiliated to another University who wish to take admission in the College are required to fill up the Enrollment form and pay the required fees. This is compulsory and if the student fail to do so he/she will not be allow to appear in the annual Examination and his/her admission will be consider cancelled.

The Following certificate / document should be attach with the admission form at the time of admission.

1. One attached copy of all the attempts of F.Y.B.Com. Examination
2. Two passport size photos.
3. Original Provisional Eligibility Certificate. [If applicable]

Important Condition after having obtain Admission.

1. Student coming from other college affiliated to other University, seeking admission in the College are required to fill up the Gujarat University Enrollment form in the event of not doing so the candidate will not permitted to take the University Exam and his/her admission will be considered cancelled. While filling up the Enrollment form attach of the copy of the mark sheet std. 12th and mark sheet of F.Y.B.Com., two passport size photographs, Attach copy of the Provisional Eligibility certificate of the University [If applicable] should be attached.
2. The attendance in compulsory and in regular taken in the College. Hence the student should attend lectures regularly. The student whose attendance falls short of the required number sat by the University will not be allowed to appear in college as well as University Examination.
3. For all work regularly admission, Examination or other work, the student should personally contact the office house.
4. It is compulsory to appear in the first and second term Exam of the college Only under rare conditions and available circumstances which are beyond control, will the student be allowed to appear in the Retest with pre-obtained permission/ assent of the principal otherwise he/she will not be allowed to appear in the Retest.
5. The Fees of second term and University should be filled in the given time period/frame else the admission will be cancelled.
6. The Student in required to keep the college I-card with his/her person.

Examination:--

1. It is Compulsory to appear in the Internal Examination conducted by the college and the University Examination.

2. Allotment of marks and calculate of % :--

3. Minimum required parsing Marks/ Percentage :-
 - Internal – 11/30
 - University – 25/70
 - In S.Y.B.Com. the marks of the main / principal subjects Advanced accountancy paper 2 and paper 3 are calculated together. The minimum required parsing marks for which are as under.
 - Internal – 22/60
 - University – 50/100
 - In care the student obtains less marks than the minimum passing marks then he/she will have to appear in the exam of both paper 2 and paper 3.
4. If the student obtains less than the required minimum marks in the Internal exam conducted by the college, it is called Internal A.T.K.T.
5. If he/she obtain less than 25 marks in the University Examination it is called External A.T.K.T.
6. If the Student obtain less marks than the minimum parsing marks in two subjects he/she gets an A.T.K.T. and is allowed to take admission in T.Y.B.Com. provided he/she has passed F.Y.B.Com.
7. If the student does not clear in S.Y.B.Com. A.T.K.T. his/her results.....The T.Y.B.Com. will be withheld. If the student obtain less marks than the required minimum marks in more than two subjects he/she is considered as fail, and will not be given admission in T.Y.B.Com. provided he/she has passed F.Y.B.COM. In the student does not clear his S.Y.B.COM. A.T.K.T. his/her result for the T.Y.B.COM. will be withheld. If the student obtain less mark than the required minimum marks in more than two subjects she/he is considered as fail, and will not be given admission in T.Y.B.COM.
8. In care of student who has an Internal A.T.K.T. in any subject the student is required to appear in its University Exam again.
9. The student who has an Internal A.T.K.T. is required to appear in the first and second Term Exam of the College.
10. Student who have External A.T.K.T. can appear in the Examination conducted by the University during the month of October – November. The forms for this examination are provided by the

University during end of October or the beginning of the month of October. (Keep an eye on the notice board.)

11. Those student who are declared fail in the University Examination cannot appear in the Examination conducted in the month of October-November. Such student can appear in the exam conducted by the University in the month of March-April. The form for this exam are available in the month of December. (Keep an eye on the notice board.)
